



## 2010 Riesling Adelaide Hills

*Riesling is the great vine variety of Germany. Noted for its wines longevity and ability to express the characteristics of the vineyard (terroir) better than any other variety. A broad spectrum of wine styles are produced from the Riesling grape, ranging from the bone dry (no residual sugar) to the super sweet (botrytised and ice wine).*

*Typically, higher quality wines are produced from cooler wine growing regions such as much of Germany and also the Alsace region in France. In Australia, the Clare and Eden Valleys, at altitudes of between 400 and 500 metres, have both made names for themselves as high quality Riesling producers. In recent times, viticulturists have discovered the Adelaide Hills (450 – 550m) region to be perfect for the growing of high quality Riesling fruit.*

*This wine has a bright pale straw appearance. The nose is beautifully fragrant and intriguing.*

*Floral aromas are intermingled with pear, grapefruit and tropical fruits.*

*The palate is racy with a steely acidity leading to a long dry finish with lingering citrus flavours.*
